During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows. 140 runs online (40%), 210 runs paper (60%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly. Canine Cash/coupons cannot be used for online entries.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- No entries will be accepted by phone, fax or email.
- Paper entries received within the first 24 hours must include postage or be metered. Entries must be delivered by multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. You must waive the signature requirement for delivery services, if any.
- Limit 10 entry forms per envelope.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC agreement are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial (AKC Rule CH 14, Sec 4).
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. Returned check fee is \$25.00.
- Only one dog per entry form; include only AKC titles on entries.
- For AKC Canine Partners, the dog's breed should be entered as "All American Dog", the listing number entered in the Registration # field, and "AKC No." box checked.
- If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.
- **Please check your entries!** Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed.

"AFTER-CLOSING" WAITING LIST

A waiting list will be kept until Monday, April 30, 2018, 6:00 pm, to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 30 entries for each day will be placed on the wait list. Any entries received by the closing date/time that are withdrawn before the waiting list deadline will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. If an entry is cancelled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by the waiting list closing date will receive a full refund.

MOVE-UPS

- **Move-ups (Prior to set of trials):** Accepted until 6:00 pm, Monday, April 30, 2018.
- **Move-ups (Day-to-Day):** BDOC will accept day-to-day move-ups. The request for moving up must be made in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary no later than the day preceding the event.

AKC JUMP HEIGHT CARDS

All dogs competing in agility **must possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. An official AKC Jump Height Card is defined as either a permanent jump height card, a valid temporary jump height form, copies of two different measuring forms (placing the dog in the same height class) dated on or after the dog's second birthday, or copies of three different measuring forms (two of which place the dog in the same height class) on or after the dog's second birthday. All dogs without jump height cards/forms must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class; this measurement will be valid for the weekend of trials only. If a Volunteer Measuring Official or an Agility Field Rep is present, all dogs without a valid jump height card/form must be measured at some time during the trial. If the dog cannot be measured by the VMO prior to running, it must be measured by the judge before its first run. **You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. You are required to mark on your entry form your dog's height card status.**

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to request measurement.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete.. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on soccer turf. Ring size will be 100' by 100' (2 rings).

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place..... Blue
Second Place..... Red
Third Place..... Yellow
Fourth Place White
Qualifying Score..... Dark Green

Placement Rosettes: Awarded to 1st thru 4th place dog in each jump height, each titling class.
 Qualifying Rosettes: Awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score in each titling class.
 New Title Rosettes: Offered to all dogs finishing an agility title at these shows.
 Double Q Rosettes: Offered to all competitors earning a qualifying score in both Masters Standard and Masters JWW.
 Triple Q Rosettes: Offered to all competitors earning a qualifying score in Masters Standard, Masters JWW, and Masters FAST.
 Quadruple Q Rosettes: Offered to all competitors earning a qualifying score in Masters Standard, Masters JWW, Masters FAST, and Time 2 Beat.
 Commemorative Rosettes: Offered to competitors earning a MACH, PACH or PAX.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

- **VERBAL AND/OR PHYSICAL ABUSE OF ANY ANIMAL WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
- **The safety of the dogs** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- **It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.** Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Bellevue Dog Obedience Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- Bellevue Dog Obedience Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Bellevue Dog Obedience Club or any official thereof.
- **All dogs must be on leash or crated** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.
- Bellevue Dog Obedience Club may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds.

REFUNDS

- **No entry fee will be refunded** if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- **No entry fee will be refunded** in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.
- **Bitches in season** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Entry fees less \$5.00 administrative fee and applicable AKC recording fees per day will be refunded for bitches coming in season after closing date. Owner must present certificate from veterinarian prior to start of show.
- **No refund** will be issued for overpayment of \$10.00 or less.

RINGSIDE

- **Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging** if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.
- **Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** The Exhibitor of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

VENDORS

- **By Permission Only.** If you would like a vendor space, please contact the trial chairman for more information.

Bellevue Dog Obedience Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

- **TRIAL HOURS:** Fri – 7:30 am to 30 minutes after end of trial.

- **EXHIBITOR CRATE SETUP - FRIDAY:** The site will be open for exhibitor setup on Friday morning at 7:30 am. **The site will not be available on Thursday evening.**
- **CRATES** may be left overnight; however, Bellevue Dog Obedience Club and the Omaha Sports Complex will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.
- **FOOD:** Food will be available for purchase Saturday and Sunday. Fast food is also available in the area. **NO FOOD OR BEVERAGE is allowed on the soccer turf.**
- **RV PARKING:** RV parking is allowed at the trial site, but hookups are not available. Please contact the trial chairman for additional information.
- **Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s).** Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
